



# Elementary Health and Safety

**Quest are delighted to be offering the Elementary Health and Safety Certificate accredited by the Royal Health Institute of Scotland.**

## **What is the qualification?**

This one - day course accredited and certificated by REHIS is designed to give delegates a general overview of all aspects of workplace health and safety including legislation and risk assessment.

On successful completion of a multiple-choice assessment paper the delegate is awarded a REHIS certificate which is generally accepted by all employers as proof of basic awareness of how to work safely.

A REHIS Elementary Health & Safety certificate can be used to qualify for the CSCS Green Labourer card exam.

## **Who might be interested?**

Any employer or employee who is responsible for Health and Safety. (all!)

## **Why do Health and Safety?**

Yes, it is a legal requirement the employers who have more than 5 employees to have a Health and Safety Policy and offer appropriate training and support to staff.

However, do we have smoke alarms in our houses because it is a legal requirement? Or do our children wear shin pads, for hockey or football because they have to? No, we do this to keep people safe and prevent injury.

So, you might come on the workshop because you need to, or because you care about being safe – either as an employer or employee.

## When can you do it?

The course will take place on **11 April 2018**. The training will be from 930am – 430pm and will include a multiple-choice exam.

Your certificate will be issued by REHIS - the Royal Environmental Health Institute of Scotland.

Investment is £90 +VAT. This includes the training day and REHIS exam.
