



Social Services (Children and Young People) SVQs



Quest are delighted to offer Social Services (Children and Young People) SVQs at SCQF level 7.

#### Who is the qualification for?

Level 7 is for Residential Childcare workers, Practitioner in Day Care. The qualification will take between 9 months and 14 months.

**SCQF Overall credit** — Minimum 68 and Maximum 93 **SCQF level 7**

They meet the registration requirements for the Scottish Social Services Council (SSSC). You can check the qualification and level you need on the this [LINK](#).

#### How do you get the qualification?

The qualification will involve you gathering evidence at work to meet the standards of the SVQ. You will be supported by an assessor from Quest and use an eportfolio to upload your evidence.

#### What do you need to do to start?

- Discuss with Quest which level and units you wish to complete
- Agree support from your employer for access to assessor, time for completing the SVQ
- You, employer and Quest sign agreement

- Complete some pre-work and submit within a deadline
- Attend a 2 hour induction on a date to be agreed.

### What do you need to achieve the qualification?

- Time to do the SVQ
- Motivation to complete the work
- Some computer skills and access to internet
- Support from your employer
- Gather evidence and follow plans set by your assessor

### Costs

SVQ level 7 is £1400 + VAT

- Some mileage/travel costs may apply

### Funding

Part-Time Fee Grant from Student Awards Agency for Scotland (SAAS)

#### *For Level 7 only*

This scheme can provide more than **£500 and up to £1195** a year towards the cost of tuition fees.

To qualify for this funding, you should have an income of £25,000 a year or less.

You need to choose your units to identify the amount of funding , as it is based on the credit values. However if you did the minimum 68 credits you could get £700, and if you complete the maximum credits of 93 you could claim £996.
